Acting Right When We Are Wronged

Acts 16:16-40

Our Scripture passage this morning brings us to Philippi, where Paul and Silas experienced some serious mistreatment while multiplying. In the face of being wronged, though, they responded in the right way. Let's examine these verses to learn about ***acting right when we are wronged***.

I. The *Wrong* Treatment (vv.16-24)

- Paul and Silas were *mistreated* in at least three ways:

II. The *Right* Response (vv.25-40)
