### **“Teach Us To Pray”**

*Luke 11:1; Matthew 6:5-13*

This morning, as we wrap up our sermon series on prayer called, *Airplane Mode*, we come to a passage of Scripture famously referred to as the Lord’s prayer. As Jesus turned His attention to prayer in His Sermon on the Mount, His disciples urged Him to teach them how to pray (*Luke 11:1*). What followed was a pattern of prayer to guide Jesus’ disciples as they prayed. Let’s unpack these verses to see what they teach us about prayer and how they can help us grow in our own prayer life.
