Luke 24:1-12; John 8:2-11

Today, we celebrate Easter, and the message of Easter is this: Christ was raised from *death* so we could have **A New Life**. Due to our past, we are all in need of new life. In our passage this morning, Jesus encountered a woman with a past who shared this same need. Let's explore the *where, what, and how* of this **New Life**...

I. New Life is Found in _____ Alone

- Jesus stands between us and the death that our sin ushers in!
- Jesus alone gives new life because He first defeated death!

II. New Life in Christ Demands _____ (8:11)

- We may never face *public scrutiny* of our sins, but we all must deal with the *private guilt* of our sins
- God wants us to _____ so we can experience new life in Christ!

III. New Life in Christ Removes _____ (8:10-11)

- Listen to the voice of conviction; not the voice of _____ (see *Romans 8:1-2*)
