Faith That Works

James 2:14-26

As we continue our study of the Book of James in a sermon series called *Faith Under Pressure*, we come to a passage that speaks to the relationship between faith and works, and the necessity of works to demonstrate the presence of true, saving faith. Specifically, in this passage James discusses three different kinds of faith to highlight a *faith that works*.

Notice	
I. A	Faith (vv.14-17)
• Do not	confuse James's teaching here with a works-based salvation.
• James s	simply confirmed that a believer's <i>identity</i> precedes his/her!
• James t	teaches about a specific kind of faith in v.14: "Can that faith save him?"
II. A	Faith (vv.18-19)
• The Wasaving	arning: belief in the existence of God does not necessarily mean that one has a true faith!
• Even _	believe things about God, Jesus, and judgment! See Mark 3:11-12; Luke 8:31; and Matthew 8:28-29
III. A	Faith (vv.20-26)
• This is	a faith that works because it effects the whole person:
	The understands the truth of God.
	The desires the truth of God.
3.	Γhe acts upon the truth of God.
