### **Radical Love**

*Luke 6:27-36*

*“If you love those who love you, what benefit is that to you?”*

- Luke 6:32

In today’s passage, Jesus calls His disciples to a love that is unlike anything the world practices or expects. Specifically, He commands us to love not merely those who love us, but even our enemies—those who oppose, harm, or mistreat us. This is a gospel-driven call to reflect the love of our Father, who has shown His kindness to us in Christ.

Notice...

#### **I. Radical Love is \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.27-28)**

- *Agapē* (Gk.) = a deliberate, self-giving love grounded in the will

#### **II. Radical Love is \_\_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.29-34)**

- Radical love treats others not according to what they \_\_\_\_\_ but according to what we \_\_\_\_\_ for ourselves!

#### **III. Radical Love is \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.35-36)**

- This kind of love displays the *gospel*, revealing we belong to *Jesus*!
