A Disciple Abides in Christ

John 15:1-8

As we continue our series, *Life in Christ: Five Marks of a Disciple*, we turn to Jesus' teaching in John 15:1-8. In this passage, Jesus teaches that true discipleship is not sustained by effort alone, but by **abiding in Him**—remaining connected, dependent, and fruitful through a living relationship with Christ. While the first mark of a disciple is a decisive commitment to Christ, this second mark focuses on the daily reality of that commitment.

Notice that *a true disciple*...

I. Abides in Christ as the Only _____ Vine (v.1)

II. Submits to the Father's _____ for More and Much Fruit (v.2)

III. Remains in Christ for _____ Fruitfulness (vv.4-5)

IV. Allows Christ to Produce through Him the _____ of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23)

V. Bears Fruit that _____ the Father and _____ Discipleship (vv.7-8)
