### **Bless the Lord**

*Psalm 103:1-22*

Psalm 103 directs our attention to the necessity of praising God. Like King David in this psalm, God's people should be occupied with God simply because of the great salvation He offers. Let's examine two main truths about the salvation of the Lord from this psalm.

Notice...

#### **I. God's Salvation Redirects Our \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.1-2, 20-22)**

- To "**ble**ss" the Lord is to *adore, revere, and praise* Him

#### **II. God's Salvation Reaps \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.2b-19)**

- David describes three blessings of God's salvation:

1. *Blessing #1*: God's Salvation Raises \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.3-5)

- See Isaiah 40:29-31

2. *Blessing #2*: God's Salvation Reaches \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.6-14)

3. *Blessing #3*: God's Salvation Reigns \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.15-19)
