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King of the Mountain

Isaiah 2:1-5

Isaiah 2:1-5 gives us a breathtaking vision of God's ultimate reign. The prophet Isaiah looks beyond the turmoil of his own day to the “latter days,” when the Lord will be exalted above every competing kingdom. Let’s examine the movements of this passage, then, as our hearts are drawn to the true ***King of the mountain***.
